**Items usually needed for all classes:** Sewing machine and your sewing machine book (in case your machine stops working), rotary cutter and board, scissors, iron (we have one iron and ironing board), extension cord, thread, straight pins, and seam ripper

## April 10, 2010:

Totes----Tool Carrier---Luggage Tags

**Supplies for Totes:** Bring your pattern and materials

**Supplies for Tool Carrier:** Bring 2 pre quilted placemats, 4 plastic zipper pencil holders, Velcro, binding and belting for handles.

**Supplies for Luggage Tag:** 1 piece of fabric (3 ¼ x 10 ¼), one piece fabric (2 ¼ x 3 ½) for strap, a piece of vinyl (2 ¼ x 3 ½), a piece of Timex

## May 8, 2010:

Miniatures

We will have patterns you can use or you can bring your own. Miniatures are a great way to use up your scraps. You can make a Miniature Quilt for Quilfest's Silent Auction or one for yourself.

**Supplies for Miniatures:** Pattern and fabric.

## June 12, 2010

Paper Piecing

Come and learn how to paper piece or work on the paper piecing for the guild's 2011 opportunity quilt.

**Supplies for Paper Piecing:** Fabric and tissue paper or some kind of thin paper to draw your design on or predrawn paper piecing patterns.

**July 10, 2010**

Nine Patch Quilt

You will be making nine patch blocks to form a quilt (54' x 54'). A pattern will be provided by the guild. No yardage is given for this quilt. You can make it as small or as large as you like and it's a great way to use up your scrapes. You can use civil war reproductions, Aunt Gracie, bights, etc.

**Supplies for Nine Patch:** Pre cut 1 ½ inch strips from light, medium and dark fabric. Also, bring 3 yards of light fabric; this can be one fabric or scraps.

**August 14, 2010**

UFO'S

Bring one of your quilting or other projects that have been in your closet for months or years. Great way to get them finished.
